NAWIC, VENTURA COUNTY CHAPTER #139 SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a Ventura County resident (OK to have temporary residence outside the county for school).
2. Complete and Sign Application. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that application and transcripts are received by May 19, 2017. (Note: Applications must be typed. Use of the form-filled application is recommended. If you will be scanning your document, please make sure it is legible prior to sending.)
3. Applications will be received via U.S. Mail to the address noted on the application or via e-mail to the committee chair Laurie Bennett at lauriebenn@aol.com

AWARDS

4. Any single scholarship award shall be not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), but is not limited to that amount.
5. Scholarship(s) will be granted through any accredited Trade School, College, University or other institution's Financial Aid Office. The scholarship grant shall be applied towards the cost of tuition and/or course expenses as selected by the recipient(s), said amount not to exceed scholarship grant.
6. The Ventura County Chapter #139 Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Appointments for personal interviews may be requested. Completed applications, current official academic transcripts and scholarship resumes must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than May 19, 2017. Applications received after that day will NOT be considered. The Scholarship Committee will select a recipient(s) and present the application(s) to the Board of Directors. Following their approval, all applicants will be notified of the Scholarship Committee's decision by June 1st.
7. Scholarships are not automatically renewed. A student will be considered for subsequent awards if he/she provides evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, continue enrollment and good standing in a program leading to a degree or trade in construction. Prior scholarship recipient(s) must reapply annually.
8. Recipient(s) should be available (although not required) for the Ventura County Chapter #139 Scholarship Dinner Meeting on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 at which time the scholarship(s) will be presented. Time and location will be determined closer to the meeting date.

The Ventura County Chapter #139 encourages applications from all individuals.
